

Students participate in multiple projects and they collaborate with peers and community stakeholders to arrive at solutions for some of society's biggest issues. Our students graduate with the courage and confidence to be the change makers in their own communities and beyond.



COLLEGE READINESS

Preparing students for success beyond ECS is at the core of what we do. Organization, study skills, and team collaboration are emphasized in every grade level and class. Students complete college-level research projects, visit numerous colleges, are provided with SAT prep and are supported through every step of the college application process. A network of peers links our alumni and parents. College-bound seniors learn about the college experience including financial aid, independent living and seeking resources and support on their college campuses.



CAREER EXPLORATION

ECS brings together local businesses and organizations to provide multiple opportunities for students to explore and develop skills that will lead them to their future careers. Students participate in internships and job shadowing and, through the Green Ambassadors Internship program, even acting as sustainability consultants for local businesses.
